The purpose of this policy is to clarify who is responsible for application of calcium/dust control within the Municipality of Pembina.

POLICY STATEMENT

- 1) The property owner that wishes calcium/dust control is responsible for the entire application process; from contacting the contractor to paying for the entire cost of calcium/dust control.
- 2) The property owner must coordinate with the municipality when the calcium/dust suppressant is to be applied to the road surface, so appropriate road maintenance can be done before the suppressant is applied. Notice must be given to the municipality at least one (1) week before the date of the application.
- Weather may factor into the maintenance of the road that can be performed and the municipality accepts no responsibility for delay of service.
- 4) The Municipality of Pembina accepts no responsibility for the effectiveness of the calcium/dust suppressant chemical.
- The Municipality of Pembina reserves the right to perform such maintenance procedures as it deems necessary on the treated portions of any the municipality's roads. Although the municipality will attempt to minimize any adverse effect of these operations on the treated portion of the roadway, the municipality will not accept liability for any restoration required.
